

Spring into Action: Public Works Preps for Warmer Weather

As the snow melts, our Operations and Facilities teams get ready to shift gears for spring.

After another busy winter maintaining arenas, plowing roads, and managing winter events, crews now turn their attention to spring maintenance. The Shallow Lake Community Centre alone saw over 2,000 ice floods this season!

With plows stored away, road crews begin street sweeping to clear winter sand, repair potholes, and launch the annual gravel road maintenance program across more than 400 kilometres of Township roads. Meanwhile, our facilities team tackles spring cleanup and park prep — maintaining 30 acres of grass each week across 27 properties.

Please drive carefully and give crews extra space as they work hard to keep Georgian Bluffs safe, clean, and ready to enjoy.

Big Changes to Waste Collection are Here!

Exciting updates are now in place for waste collection in Georgian Bluffs!

Starting this month, the Township will introduce a new wheeled-bin system for garbage and recycling, and for the first time, a Green Bin program for food and organic waste.

These changes will make waste collection cleaner, safer, and more efficient. **Bag tags will be a thing of the past**, replaced by Townshipprovided bins designed for easy curbside pickup.

The Province of Ontario has also taken over responsibility for Blue Box recycling, with service managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO). While recycling collection will continue, it will now fall under the province's new extended producer responsibility program.

From Estimate to Exact: Your Annual Tax Bill's Journey

August brings the first installment of your finalized property tax bill for the year. Here's how the process works:

The first two tax installments you paid earlier this year were interim bills, calculated using the previous year's tax rate to bridge the gap from the end of 2025 until the 2026 budget is approved. This approach allows us to keep funding essential services while the current year's budget is being finalized.

Now that the budgets and new tax rates have been approved by the Township and the County, your August and October bills reflect the new rate.

This ensures the Township can provide year-round services while allowing time for careful budget consideration, ensuring your property taxes pay for the community services and infrastructure investments that matter most.

Rooted in Care: Fall Cleanup the Natural Way

As the leaves begin to fall, it can be tempting to rake every corner of your yard — but a little mess can do a lot of good!

Fallen leaves provide shelter for pollinators, butterflies, and other small creatures that overwinter in leaf litter and soil. They also break down into a natural mulch that enriches your garden and helps retain moisture for spring growth.

If you can, **leave the leaves** under trees and shrubs, or mulch them into your lawn. For areas that do need tidying, use paper leaf bags or your compost bin instead of plastic.

These small actions help protect biodiversity, reduce waste, and support healthier soil, all while saving you time and effort.

This fall, try letting nature do the cleanup. Together, we can keep Georgian Bluffs deeply rooted and sustainably growing, one backyard at a time.

When the snow starts to fall, our Public Works crews are ready!

Each winter, the Township maintains more than 400 kilometres of roads, ensuring safe travel for residents, school buses, and emergency vehicles.

Snow removal is a round-theclock effort. Crews head out as early as conditions require, working through the night to keep roads and intersections clear.

You can help by giving plows plenty of space, keeping vehicles off the road during snow events, and avoiding pushing snow onto the roadway when clearing driveways.

Please be patient! Our teams work hard in challenging conditions to keep the community moving safely.

With lake-effect snow, we get some of the highest snowfall rates in Canada! Always be prepared in case you get snowed in, and check on vulnerable friends and neighbours.






